



GSE PACKING LIST--RECOMMENDED ITEMS

- Dress business apparel attire for opening ceremony, pitch day, and reporting day. Males should have a suit or sports coat with dress shirt and tie. If you do not have a sports coat or tie, you will need dress slacks, a long-sleeved dress shirt and tie. Since there are several days you will be wearing such apparel, you might consider extra shirts. You can also wash and iron if you only bring one.
- Females should wear business dresses or pants suits for the opening ceremony (the evening dinner and ceremony—not all day), pitch day, and reporting day.
- Attire for the Governor’s Gala and Awards Banquet includes the same description for males as listed above. For females, “dressy” dresses, such as “the little black dress” are suggested. Although the Gala is called “formal,” it is not an event for prom-style dresses, so no “evening gowns,” no bare midriffs and no backless frocks.
- Athletic shorts (preferably black—5 pairs suggested)
- Old jean shorts (to be paint-stained during an event)
- 1 Pair nice (no holes) jeans or skirt (for field trip to Charlotte). Jeans should be regular indigo-colored or black—not colored.
- Jean shorts (for day at Bechtel Reserve)
- Sleepwear
- Daily appropriate classroom attire (see handbook—Expectations and)
- Appropriate under garments
- Socks, including athletic socks for pm activities
- At least one, and possibly two, swimming suits

Note: Students will receive a GSE t-shirt and sports shirt to wear during field trips.

SHOES

- Old shoes (to be paint-stained during an event)
- Athletic Shoes (for day at Bechtel Reserve)
- Running Shoes (optional AM runs / mandatory PM group activities)
- Casual Shoes (for classroom / field trip to Charlotte)
- Dress Shoes (for Opening Banquet, Pitch Day, Governor’s Gala)
- Flip flops / Shower Shoes

PERSONAL ITEMS:

(Each student will receive one fresh linen pack with bed linens and seven towels. They will also receive a \$10 laundry credit on their MU ID Cards which is enough for 5 loads of laundry. Additional laundry costs are \$2.00 to wash and dry. Toilet paper will be provided by the residence hall.)

- Pillow and blankets

- Hair dryer
- Toiletries (razors, shaving cream, soap, all hair care products, skin care products, cologne, etc.)
- Tooth paste
- Deodorant
- Soap
- Hygiene items
- Trash can and garbage bags
- Laundry detergent and dryer sheets. No chlorine bleach
- Alarm clock (if you don't use your phone for a clock)
- Hangers
- Desk Lamp
- 3M strips if you choose to decorate your room with posters. No other tape is allowed.
